With the touch of a button, for example, you can change entire registrations, or program chord progressions for complete songs, or transfer voices from section to section on the keyboard.

The control panel has an extremely simple design for easy operation. Anyone can learn to use it in a very short time. Used in combination with the "hidden features" of the Multi-Menu, it provides enormous versatility.



Three features that make it easy.

Registration Menu gives you the sound you need for the style you want at the touch of a button.

The Registration
Menu is a selection of
16 pre-programmed
registrations, or
groups of panel settings, including voices,
effects, rhythms and volumes. Each setting is programmed for a different

style of music, from woodwind and string ensembles to jazz, country, pops and fusion—so you can get the sound you need for the style you want at the touch of a button.

Registration Memory lets you change entire control panel settings in an instant.

You can store up to four of your favorite settings (including preset registrations from the Multi-Menu) in the Registration Memory* before you play. Then, during your performance, you can switch entire registrations by pressing a button. This means you can change your whole sound in the middle of a song.

The Auto Bass Chord (ABC) feature, which automatically adds matching bass lines and chord patterns to your rhythms, lets you play perfect bass and chord accompaniments with one finger. (Or more, if you want.) This means you can start sounding great the moment you sit down at your ME Electone — even if you've never touched a keyboard before.

Arpeggio Chords add spice to vour playing.

With the Arpeggio Chord feature, which works in conjunction with the Auto Rhythms, you can add sophisticated rhythmic arpeggios to your chords. The arpeggio patterns and instrument sounds are 'custom' designed for every rhythm.



The ME-50's RAM Pack system gives you virtually infinite capacity to store your registrations and C.S.P. data.

Chord Sequence Programmer expands your performing capabilities.

The Multi-Menu's Chord Sequence Programmer lets you preprogram chord sequences and play them back automatically. This allows you to concentrate on getting your melodies just right, and greatly expands your performing capabilities.



Transposition function lets you change keys in mid-performance.

The transposition function, which is located on one page of the Multi-Menu, lets you instantly change key within a one-octave range.

Multi-function Foot Switch gives you greater playing freedom.

The multi-function Foot Switch frees your hands to concentrate on your playing. With it, you can:

1. Add a Fill In pattern

2. Stop and restart the rhythm

3. End a song with a preset pattern

4. Glide from one solo note to another

More than two dozen voices.

The ME Electones give you a wide range of Yamaha's unique FM (Frequency Modulation) voices, including everything from traditional String and Brass ensembles, Pipe Organ, Harpsichord, Piano, Soprano Sax, Flugelhorn and Timpani, to Electric Piano, Electric Bass, several guitar sounds, Cosmic Brass, and much more.

To simplify operation, only a few of these

voices have been placed on the control panel. The rest are on the Multi-Menu cylinder, from where they can easily be transferred to any voice section.



Melody On Chord, Tremolo, Vibrato and Sustain.

All ME Series Electones accommodate Yamaha's optional new KA-10 external Keyboard Amplifiers. These lightweight powered speakers are small (11 cm [4 1/3"] full range), but with a power rating of 30 watts they deliver a truly powerful sound.

Multi-menu is a 10-faced cylinder that gives you enormous flexibility. You call up each menu page simply b rotating the thumbwheel.

The menu pages are as follows:

Registration Menu

Choose from 16 preset registration covering voices, rhythms, the degree of each effect and all voice/rhythm volume settings.

Chord Sequence Programmer (C.S.P.)

Lets you input chord sequences and registrations one at a time. Lets you store up to two songs having up to 150 chords each. Melody On Chord automatically transforms single note melodies into harmonies.

Tremolo, which you can use with the upper and lower orchestral voices, simulates a rotating speaker sound.

Vibrato and Sustain features are preset, but you can program their parameters with the Multi-Menu.



The MIDI interface gives you almost unlimited expansion potential.

More than a dozen rhythms.

The ME Electones give you a wide choice of Yamaha's unique FWM (Full Wave Memory) Auto Rhythms, in-

cluding Latin, Swing, Waltz, Slow Rock, Ballad, 8 Beat, 16 Beat, and much more.

If you want, you can add Fill Ins, Intro/ Ending patterns and Extra Percussion sounds which automatically vary from rhythm to rhythm.

Almost infinitely expandable.

Since all ME Electones are equipped with the world standard MIDI (Musical Instrument Digital Interface), there is virtually no limit to their expansion capabilities. They can control or be controlled by synthesizers, drum computers, electronic keyboards and/or all other MIDI-equipped devices.

The Cassette and Registration Pack system gives you unlimited memory capacity. It lets you store registration memory data and C.S.P. data separately on tape by connecting a cassette recorder. On the ME-50, it also lets you store this data in a Registration RAM Pack cartridge.

FAM System: The secret behind the sound

All ME Series voices are generated by Yamaha's exclusive FAM (Frequency Modulation and Advanced Memory) system, which

makes both the musical voices and rhythms sound authentic.

FM tone generation (and rhythm generation for ME-10) precisely matches the shape of the sound waves, and controls the complex harmonics as they change through their decay period, thereby giving each voice the same sound characteristics as the real instrument.

FWM percussion sounds (ME-50 and ME-30) are actual digital recordings of real percussion instruments — stored in an LSI memory chip.

The ME-10 also has a convenient Automatic Registration feature which matches preprogrammed registrations with each individual Auto Rhythm.

The ME-30 has a great many more features, including the powerful Multi-Menu, an expanded Auto Bass Chord, Melody ON Chord, Arpeggio Chord, extra percussion sounds, and an extraordinary range of voices.

The ME-50, at the top of the line, has all this and even more. Including, for the first time ever in an Electone of this price range, Registration Memory and the Registration Pack system. It also offers the multifunction Foot Switch, and an
