Installation to the back of the Electron takes a matter of seconds and the Plus 1 Electron extension unit may be installed in the back of ROMBOX. A multi-way cable with connectors is provided for using ROMBOX with the BBC and here again, installation can be completed within seconds. Comprehensive fitting and operating instructions are provided.
