Prestel terminals are now available in many public libraries at no cost to the user.

Secretaries of affiliated clubs are kept informed of the activities of the other clubs and of the ALCC itself. Clubs can also apply to ClubSpot 810 to have their details on Prestel, and to edit these themselves.
