Key Features

- The BASIC Editor is a utility ROM which provides powerful and sophisticated facilities for developing and maintaining BASIC programs.
- 2. Many of the features of a word processor are provided such as the ability to move or copy blocks of program lines. In addition, The BASIC Editor enables the programmer to define the target of jump instructions as labels and then automatically insert the appropriate line number when the editing session is complete.
- 3. When the program has been edited it is possible to switch to BASIC and run the program immediately, and then, if necessary, return to The BASIC Editor for modifications to be made.
- 4. The BASIC Editor is supplied on a 16K ROM with a comprehensive user guide, and can be used on any BBC Microcomputer with the 1.0 operating system or a later version.
